Appropriate Clothing

Emergency Contacts

Parents are reminded to ensure that correct contact numbers and names for all adults who can pick up your child in an emergency. We are unable to send the children home with anyone that you have not pre-notified us of. This is important for the welfare of your child.

COVID -19 update

If you have any of the main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), get a test as soon as possible. Stay at home until you get the result.

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
- Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms

1.6 Use of mobile phones and cameras

Policy statement

We take steps to ensure that there are effective procedures in place to protect children, young people, and vulnerable adults from the unacceptable use of mobile phones and cameras in the setting.

Procedures

Personal mobile phones

Personal mobile phones belonging to our staff and volunteers are not used on the premises during working hours.

At the beginning of each individual's shift, personal mobile phones are stored in lockers, or in the office if a locker is not available.

In the event of an emergency, personal mobile phones may be used in privacy, where there are no children present, with permission from the manager

Our staff and volunteers ensure that the work telephone number is known to immediate family and the people who need to contact them in an emergency.

Our staff and volunteers will not use their personal mobile phones for taking photographs of children on outings. The nursery mobile phone is taken on trips only and the only circumstance that is acceptable is the Nursery Manager who will take her phone if necessary if on the trip.

Parents and visitors are requested not to use their mobile phones whilst on the premises. Visitors will be advised of a quiet space where they can use their mobile phone, where there are no children present.

Cameras and videos

Our staff and volunteers must not bring their own cameras or video recorders into the setting.

Photographs and recordings of children are only taken for valid reasons, i.e. to record their learning and development, or for displays within the setting whilst children are present.

Photographs or recordings of children are only taken on equipment belonging to the setting.

Cameras are kept in the nursery office and the chip is deleted each day and photos are deleted off the computer when we have finished with these.

Camera and video use is monitored by our manager in the setting

Where parents request permission to photograph or record their own children at special events, permission will first be gained from all parents for their children to be included.
