

Home Learning Environment

The EYFS is very clear about the role of the home learning environment in improving outcomes for children. Research shows that the home learning environment has the greatest impact on outcomes for children that is why the EYFS places a greater emphasis on the role of practitioners in supporting parents in improving the home learning environment.

Please see below for a list of activities that research shows to have the biggest impact.

The main activities include:

1. Parents and children looking at and reading books
2. Parents taking children to the library
3. Children exploring letters and numbers through play activities and experiences
4. Parents teaching children a variety of songs and rhymes
5. Children participating in art and craft activities
6. Children being involved in every day routines e.g. cooking in the evening
7. Both Fathers and Mothers taking part in activities

The nursery will provide regular workshops, help and advice to parents on a regular basis.
